Salvation Is A Completely Free Gift

God saved you by His grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.

EPHESIANS 2:8-9 NLT



If salvation is based on our performance -- on what we do -- then it is not by grace (but by works). Our salvation is based on what Jesus Christ did. Our part is simply to receive the gift! That's the Good News—the Gospel.

It has been God's plan from the very beginning. We see it from Genesis to Revelation!

Abraham was, humanly speaking, the founder of our Jewish nation. What did he discover about being made right with God? If his good deeds had made him acceptable to God, he would have had something to boast about. But that was not God's way. For the Scriptures tell us, "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." When people work, their wages are not a gift, but something they have earned. ROMANS 4:1-4 NLT

Salvation cannot be a free gift and also be something we must earn. Either we earn it, or it is a gift. It cannot be a mixture of the two.

If you claim to give me a gift, but you ask me for any payment -- no matter how small -- then it is not a gift but something I am buying for a reduced price. Buying something on sale does not make it a gift. If there is any payment involved, by definition, it is not a gift.

But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace. **ROMANS 11:6 NASB**

Today, just as in Bible times, there are those who teach that being right with God can only be achieved by keeping their list of rules. But this is not the true teaching of the New Covenant.

But then some of the believers who belonged to the sect of the Pharisees stood up and insisted, "The Gentile converts must be circumcised and required to follow the law of Moses." So why are you now challenging God by burdening the Gentile believers with a yoke that neither we nor our ancestors were able to bear? We believe that we are all saved the same way, by the undeserved grace of the Lord Jesus." ACTS 15:5,10-11 NLT




