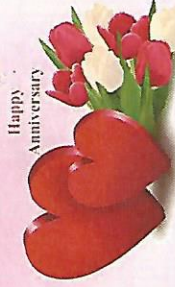

His unconditional LOVE for us EMPOWERS us to be His heart, His hand, His voice... His life as we live our lives anticipating each new day and the miracles that will follow us!

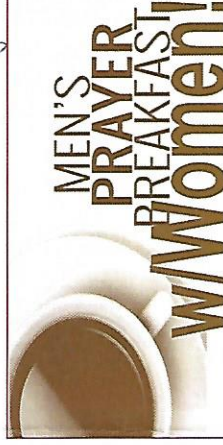
We will continue this theme through June into July as we prepare for our FRESH WIND Conference for 2021!

We broke ground on July 6, 2002 (7602 which is also our address!) We will be completing our Capital. Funds Campaign at the end of July, 2022. We began the campaign in August of 2019 (our 20th anniversary together as a new church in Licking County) with a goal of \$70,000. As of April 18th 2021, we have received pledges of \$67,687.74. Of that amount we have received \$50,572.50. The funds have been used to repair, coat and stripe our parking lot (completed), repair our roof sealing all leaks (mostly done including the repair of our HVAC units), new carpet in Sanctasium and flooring in café (to be completed soon, painting and updating the rest of the church as far as funds are available. We decided we would NOT go into debt for any of these updates and we haven't needed to - PEASE THE LORD! We are in the home stretch and I am very proud of all of you for the donations and the sweat equity you have given to this campaign to continue to be good stewards of God's house. Thank you and we thank God for this incredible facility from which to lift our hearts in worship and praise of our precious LORD JESUS CHRIST—our hope for eternal future and for our children and our children's children.
